However, if due to inclement weather, ARTIST agrees to reschedule performance to another date within the same calendar year, PURCHASER will also reimburse ARTIST for all out pocket expenses and sign new agreement for rescheduled date. This is solely at the discretion of ARTIST and ARTIST's agent (GP Entertainment). Fee of rescheduled show cannot be guaranteed to be the same as the original show.
